STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Concerning the Sale of Certain Firecrackers.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 5 follows:

8 MRSA $\S221$, sub-\$1, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 23, \$2, is amended to read:

1. Fireworks. "Fireworks" means: Any combustible or explosive composition or substance; any combination of such compositions or substances; any other article, which was prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration or detonation, including blank cartridges or toy cannons in which explosives are used, the type of balloon which requires fire underneath to propel it, firecrackers, torpedoes,

1 skyrockets, roman candles, bombs, rockets, wheels, 2 colored fires, fountains, mines, serpents or other fireworks of like construction; any fireworks con-3 4 taining any explosive or flammable compound; or any 5 tablets or other device containing any explosive sub-6 stance or flammable compound. The term "fireworks" 7 as used in this chapter does not include toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns or other devices in which paper 8 caps or plastic caps containing 25/100 grains or less 9 of explosive compound are used, if they are con-10 11 structed so that the hand cannot come in contact with 12 the cap when in place for the explosion, or toy pistol paper caps or plastic caps which contain less than 20/100 grains of explosive mixture or sparklers 13 14 15 not contain magnesium that do chlorates or 16 perchlorates, or small paper-wrapped pyrotechnic devices, "snappers" so-called, each unit containing 17 less than 0.20 grain of pyrotechnics compound, im-18 pregnated with no more than 0.0008 gram of silver 19 fulminate and approximately 0.15 gram of coarse sand. 20

STATEMENT OF FACT

22 This bill allows the sale of small pyrotechnic 23 devices which make a snapping sound when dropped.
