COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1062, L.D. 1445, Bill, "AN ACT to Facilitate Access to In-home Services."

Amend the Bill in section 1 in subsection 11-A by striking out all of the last 4 lines (page 2, lines 8 to 11 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: 'In addition, this term does not apply to hospitals, skilled nursing facilities or intermediate care facilities providing in-home services, except from licensure under section 2147, subsection 10, to 6 or fewer clients at any one time.'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in subsection 10 in the last line (page 2, line 21 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word "designee" the following: 'when it is documented in the patient's record that the licensed home health care agency or agencies serving the patient's area:

A. Have indicated that they are unable to provide those services; or

B. Agree that the plan of care is an acceptable plan.

The plan of care must meet standards for staff qualifications and supervision consistent with the standards required of licensed home health care providers'
