1 **Resolve, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities**
2 **on Account of Taxes Lost Due to Lands**
3 **being Classified under the Maine Tree**
4 **Growth Tax Law.**

6 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts and resolves
7 of the Legislature do not become effective until 90
8 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies;
9 and

10 Whereas, certain municipalities have been reim-
11 bursed 75% of the tax loss pursuant to the Maine Re-
12 vised Statutes, Title 36, section 578, and there re-
13 mains money due these municipalities; and

14 Whereas, certain municipalities currently need
15 the remaining reimbursement funds due to the taxes
16 lost; and

1 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
2 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
3 the Constitution of Maine and require the following
4 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
5 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
6 therefore, be it

7 **Reimbursements to be paid to certain municipali-**
8 **ties. Resolved:** That the following designated munic-
9 ipalities be reimbursed for the sums indicated total-
10 ing \$115,247.12 under the provisions of the Maine
11 Tree Growth Tax Law pursuant to the Maine Revised
12 Statutes, Title 36, section 578, subsection 1:
