AN ACT Relating to Training of Sewage
Treatment Operators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §4173-A, sub-§3, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1985, c. 204, is amended to read:

3. Self supporting. This program shall be self-
supporting from fees, grants or other sources of revenue
~~not-including-the-General-Fund.~~

Sec. 2. Appropriation. The following funds are
appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the
purposes of this Act.
