1 **AN ACT to Amend the Liquor Licensing Laws.**

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 Sec. 1. 28-A MRSA §1012, sub-§1, as enacted by
6 PL 1987, c. 45, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

7 1. Incorporated civic organizations. An incor-
8 porated civic organization may obtain ~~a~~ license up to
9 5 licenses per year to sell spirits, wine and malt
10 liquor to be consumed on the premises.

11 A. The license fee for each license
12 is.....\$ 50.

13 B. The license is valid for only one event per
14 year.

1 the one-day licenses is the same as the current ap-
2 plication procedure for the 7-day license.

3 It is estimated that this bill will increase the
4 number of licenses issued to incorporated civic orga-
5 nizations. An estimate of 10 additional licenses at
6 \$50 per license will result in an additional \$500
7 going to the General Fund.

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
