9 1. Mandated review. If a court has made a final
10 protection order, it shall review the case at least
11 once within 18 months of the final protection order
12 and at least every 2 years thereafter, unless the
13 child has been emancipated or adopted. ~~If the court~~
14 ~~has ordered custody to any person, other than a par-~~
15 ~~ent or the department, no subsequent judicial review~~
16 ~~is required unless petitioned for by any party or un-~~
17 ~~less specifically ordered by the court.~~
