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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1093, L.D.
1484, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the State Funding of
Pollution Abatement Projects."

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Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1
and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §411, first ¶, as amended by PL
1985, c. 689, §§1 and 3, is further amended to read:

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The department may pay an amount ~~at least 15%~~
~~but~~ not to exceed 45% of the expense of a municipal
or quasi-municipal pollution abatement construction
program or a pollution abatement construction program
in an unorganized township or plantation authorized
by the county commissioners. The department may pay
up to 90% of the expense of a municipal or quasi-mu-
nicipal pollution abatement construction program or a
pollution abatement construction program in an unor-
ganized township or plantation authorized by the
county commissioners in which the construction cost
of the project does not exceed \$100,000 so long as
total expenditures for the small projects do not ex-
ceed \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year and not more than
one grant is made to any applicant each year, except
that the department may pay up to 50% of the expense
of individual projects serving seasonal dwellings or
commercial establishments. The application for a
grant under this paragraph for a project serving a
single-family dwelling, including outbuildings, or a
single commercial establishment, shall include a
signed statement of the financial condition of the
owner of the single-family dwelling or commercial es-
tablishment describing the need for the grant. That
statement will become part of the application record
and no further evidence of need will be required.'
