3 STATE OF MAINE 4 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 5 113TH LEGISLATURE 6 FIRST REGULAR SESSION COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "H" 7 H.P. 1093, L.D. to 8 1484, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the State Funding of Pollution Abatement Projects." 9 10 Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 11 and inserting in its place the following: 12 'Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §411, first ¶, as amended by PL 13 1985, c. 689, §§1 and 3, is further amended to read: The department may pay an amount at-least-15%7 but not to exceed 45%7 of the expense of a municipal 14 15 or quasi-municipal pollution abatement construction 16 17 program or a pollution abatement construction program 18 in an unorganized township or plantation authorized 19 the county commissioners. The department may pay by 20 up to 90% of the expense of a municipal or quasi-mu-21 nicipal pollution abatement construction program or a 22 pollution abatement construction program in an unorganized township or plantation authorized by the county commissioners in which the construction cost 23 24 of the project does not exceed \$100,000 so long 25 as total expenditures for the small projects do not ex-26 27 ceed \$1,000,000 in any fiscal year and not more than one grant is made to any applicant each year, except that the department may pay up to 50% of the expense 28 29 30 individual projects serving seasonal dwellings or of 31 commercial establishments. The application for а 32 grant under this paragraph for a project serving a 33 single-family dwelling, including outbuildings, or а 34 single commercial establishment, shall include а signed statement of the financial condition of the 35 36 owner of the single-family dwelling or commercial es-37 tablishment describing the need for the grant. That statement will become part of the application record and no further evidence of need will be required.' 38 39
