1 AN ACT to Amend the Retirement Law Regarding
2 Schools.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 5 MRSAs §17763, sub-§3, as enacted by PL 1985, c.
7 801, §§5 and 7, is repealed.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This new draft replaces the original bill. The
3 present law allows teachers who have taught in public
4 schools for 10 years and who previously had taught in
5 a parochial or private school to purchase up to 10
6 years of service credit in the Maine State Retirement
7 System for the years they taught in the private or
8 parochial school. The teacher pays the full actuari-
9 al cost of the benefit for the additional years and
10 there is no cost to the State.

11 This new draft repeals the section of law which
12 states that the teacher must have started teaching in
13 public schools before January 1, 1976, and began pay-
14 ments as of that date or within 30 days of becoming
15 eligible. This new draft has no cost to the State or
16 local school units. The total cost is paid by the
17 teacher purchasing the service credit.

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
