## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 113TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1115, L.D. 1509, "Resolve,
Establishing the Special Commission to Study the Use of State
Valuation in Allocation of State Funding Among Municipalities."

Amend the resolve, in the 9th paragraph after the title, in the 8th and 9th lines (page 2, lines 32 and 33 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Both parties shall be represented by legislative members."

14 Further amend the resolve, in the 9th paragraph after the 15 title, in the 4th line from the end (page 3, line 6 in L.D.) 16 by inserting after the following: "service." the following: 17 'Each appointing authority shall make appointments which ensure 18 representation from both political parties.'

19 Further amend the resolve, in the appropriation, by striking 20 out all of the 11th line (page 4, line 8 in L.D.) and inserting 21 in its place the following:

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment provides that all appointing authorities will make appointments to the commission in a manner which will ensure representation from each political party. It also corrects the appropriation.
