IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Remove the Responsibility of the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources to Pay for Wildlife Damage.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

12 MRSA §7035, sub-§3, %C, as enacted by PL 1985, 408, §2, is amended to read: c.

C. Agents may be utilized for the benefit of agricultural interests provided-that-the-department shall--be--reimbursed--annually--for--the-cost-of those-efforts-by-the-Bepartment--of--Agriculture, Food--and-Rural-Resources-from-funds-specifically appropriated-or-otherwise-made-available--to--the Department--of--Agriculture7--Food--and-Rural-Resources-for-that-purpose.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

2 Present law states that the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources reimburse the De-partment of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for costs 3 4 associated with the controlling of wildlife for the 5 6 benefit of agricultural interests from funds specifi-7 cally appropriated or otherwise made available to the 8 Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Resources for that purpose. As funds have not been appropri-ated or otherwise made available, the bill removes the Department of Agriculture, Food and Rural Re-9 10 11 sources' obligation to reimburse the Department 12 of 13 Inland Fisheries and Wildlife.

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
