Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1

and 2.

Further amend the bill in section 3 in the first

line (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the

following: "Sec. 3."

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end

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before the statement of fact the following:

'FISCAL NOTE

This bill will affect a minimum number of cases.

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Any additional cost to the Judicial System can be ab-

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sorbed within existing resources.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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The purpose of this amendment is to delete the

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sections of the bill that would have repealed the

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provision of the Maine Juvenile Code permitting the

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juvenile and prosecuting attorney to consent to a

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preadjudication diagnostic evaluation of the juve-

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nile.
