With the exception of matters concerning collections security and preservation, decisions made by the director concerning access, use and reproduction of museum collections may be appealed to the commission within 30 days for final determination by the commission;
20 21 22 23 24 25	Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§85-A." in subsection 8 in the next to the last and the last line (page 2, lines 40 and 41 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "museum. Protection through copyrights may be obtained;" and inserting in its place the following: 'museum;'
26 27 28 29 30	Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "§85-A." in subsection 9 in the last line (page 3, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "research;" and inserting in its place the following: 'research. Protection through copyright law may be obtained;'
32 33 34	Further amend the bill in section 4 by striking out the first 2 lines and inserting in their place the following:

4 5 6 7 8 9	This bill authorizes the Maine State Museum to credit the proceeds from sales of reproductions of collections to either of 2 dedicated accounts. Presently, any proceeds from these sales go to the General Fund; no funds have been collected from such sales to date. The amount of General Fund revenues foregone cannot be determined.'

12 13 14 15 16	The purpose of this amendment is to add a fiscal note, make 2 technical corrections to the bill and add an appeals process from decisions of the director concerning access, use and reproduction of museum collections.
