1 AN ACT to Permit Participants to Play Beano
2 in 2 or more Rooms.

4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 17 MRSA §311, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1975, c.
7 307, §2, is amended to read:

8 5. Location permit. "Location permit" shall mean
9 means that card issued by the Chief of the State Po-
10 lice, describing the premises or area in which
11 "Beano" "beano" may be conducted. Such location per-
12 mit must be accompanied by a license. Only such loca-
13 tions expressly described in the location permit
14 shall be used for the conduct of any game. No rule
15 promulgated under this chapter may limit beano games
16 to the confines of one room.
