AN ACT to Amend the Tri-state Lotto
Compact.

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4 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
5 follows:

6 Sec. 1. 8 MRSa §404, sub-§4, as enacted by PL
7 1983, c. 732, §1, is amended to read:

8 4. Party states. "Party states" means the states
9 of New Hampshire, Vermont and Maine and any other
10 states permitted to join the compact pursuant to sec-
11 tion 418.

12 Sec. 2. 8 MRSa §418, as enacted by PL 1983, c.
13 732, §1, is amended to read:

14 §418. Duration of commission and Tri-state Lotto

1 Section 2 of the bill allows the member states of
2 the Tri-state Lotto to add additional states with
3 unanimous agreement of the Tri-state Lotto Commis-
4 sion, the party states' commissions and the Gover-
5 nor. The new state must adopt the Tri-state Lotto
6 Compact and have concurrent legislation as defined in
7 the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 8, section 404,
8 subsection 2. It also allows the Tri-state Lotto
9 Commission to change its name or the name of the
10 lotto game, as appropriate.

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
