"Standards of construction" means the standards adopted by rule by the Director of Public Improvements and the standards set forth by the American National Standards Institute in the publication "Specifications for Making Buildings and Facilities Accessible to and Usable by the Physically Handicapped," {ANSI-A-117-1961-(R-1971)};-as

amended, except as otherwise exempted or provided by
