5 6	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
7 8	39 MRSA $\S23$, sub- $\S4$, $\S6$, as amended by PL 1977, c. 696, $\S402$, is further amended to read:
9 .0 .1 .2 .3 .4 .5 .6	G. If an employer is a partnership, or a sole proprietorship, and is a member of a self-insurance group associated pursuant to this section, such employer may elect to include as an "employee" any member of such partnership, or owner of such sole proprietorship, for purposes of obtaining workers' compensation coverage under this Act. In the event of such election, the

1	electing employer shall serve upon the group
2	self-insurance association written notice naming
3	the partner or sole proprietor to be covered, and
4	no election shall be deemed to have been made
5	within this Act until such notice has been given.
6	By making such an election, the partnership mem-
7	ber or sole proprietor shall be deemed to have
8	stipulated that for premium payment purposes the
9	weekly annual salary or wage of such electing
10	partnership member or sole proprietor is \$200-per
11	week the average weekly wage in the State as com-
12	puted by the Bureau of Employment Security multi-
13	plied by 52 and rounded to the nearest \$100. The
14	assumed average annual wage shall be adjusted as
15	of July 1st using the average weekly wage from
16	the prior calendar year.

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 39, section 23, subsection 4, paragraph G, establishes the presumed payroll for premium purposes for partnerships and sole proprietors at \$200 per week. As wage levels have risen, this figure is out of date. This bill introduces a procedure by which the assumed annual wage for premium purposes is based on the average annual wage in this State during the prior calendar year.

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
