AN ACT Converting West Forks Plantation into

2 3	the Town of West Forks.
4	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
5	lature do not become effective until 90 days after
6	adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
7	Whereas, the voters of West Forks Plantation are
8	desirous of holding a referendum to determine whether
9	West Forks Plantation should be converted into the
10	Town of West Forks; and
11 12	Whereas, if the voters approve the referendum, it is desirable to organize the new town government as

soon as possible so that the new Town of West Forks

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- 1 may begin to govern itself in a manner that a majori-2 ty of the voters have chosen; and
 - Whereas, the actual incorporation cannot be accomplished until this Act takes effect; and

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- 5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 6 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 7 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 8 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-9 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 10 therefore,
- 11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
 12 follows:
- 13 Sec. 1. Town of West Forks, incorporated. West 14 Forks Plantation, with its inhabitants, is incorporated into a town by the name of West Forks. The in-15 16 habitants of this town are vested with the powers, privileges and immunities which the inhabitants of towns within the State do or may enjoy. The town 17 18 The town created shall take the effects belonging to West 19 20 Forks Plantation and shall also assume all of its ob-21 ligations.
 - Sec. 2. Legislative district. Until the next legislative apportionment of Representatives, the Town of West Forks shall remain in the same legislative district in which West Forks Plantation is now classed.
 - Sec. 3. First meeting; how called. Upon acceptance of this Act by referendum as provided in section 4, the board of assessors of the plantation shall issue a warrant, in accordance with the general laws, for the first town meeting, to be held within one year after passage of this Act. Notification of the town meeting shall be filed by the plantation clerk with the Secretary of State for determining the effective date of sections 1 and 2.
 - Sec. 4. Referendum; certificate to Secretary of State. The board of assessors of the plantation shall submit this Act to the legal voters within the

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	territory embraced within the limits of the proposed Town of West Forks, by ballot, at a regular or special election to be held within one year after passage of this Act. This election shall be called, advertised and conducted according to the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30, sections 2061 and 2065. The plantation clerk shall prepare the required ballots, on which he shall reduce the subject matter of sections 1 and 2 of this Act to the following question.
10 11	"Shall West Forks Plantation be incorporated into the Town of West Forks?"
12 13 14 15 16 17 18 19 20	The voters shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the word "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This Act shall be approved by a majority of the legal voters voting at the election, provided that the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of sections 1 and 2 of this Act at the election equaled or exceeded 50% of the total number of votes cast in the plantation for Governor at the last gubernatorial election.
21 22 23 24	The result of the vote shall be declared by the board of assessors of West Forks Plantation and due certificate shall be filed by the plantation clerk with the Secretary of State.
25 26 27 28 29 30	Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, section 3 of this Act shall take effect upon its acceptance by a majority of the legal voters at the election. Sections 1 and 2 of this Act shall take effect for all purposes at the first town meeting.
31	STATEMENT OF FACT
32 33	The purpose of this bill is set out in the emergency preamble.
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
