For any person to knowing-10. 25 ly sell irradiated food. 26 STATEMENT OF FACT 27 This new draft carries out the intent of the 28 original bill to protect Maine consumers from any po-29 tential hazards of food which has been irradiated 30 with gamma radiation or other ionizing radiation. draft prohibits the knowing 31 sale of The new 32 irradiated food, with the exception of irradiated spices when those spices are only an ingredient in 33 34 the food. Irradiated spices are irradiated food and 35 their knowing sale is prohibited.

The committee notes that use of food irradiation is not widespread at present and that, in the opinion of the responsible state agencies, existing studies of the safety of irradiated food are insufficient. The new draft leaves it to the Legislature to decide at any future time whether further study has estab-lished the safety of irradiated food. (2)
