AN ACT to Clarify Capital Reimbursements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:

Sec. 1. 34-A MRSA §1210, sub-§5, ¶¶C and D, as
enacted by PL 1985, c. 821, §18, are amended to read:

C. Commodities:

(1) Food;

(2) Fuel; and

(3) Supplies:

(a) Cleaning;

18 STATEMENT OF FACT

19 The law does not clearly distinguish between re-
20 imbursement for capital expenditures as a result of
21 regular replacement of equipment, furniture, fix-
22 tures, vehicles and capital expenditures as it re-
23 flects the actual increase in jail population from
24 the net gain of prisoners as reflected in the Maine
25 Revised Statutes, Title 17-A, section 1203, subsec-
26 tion 1, and section 1252, subsection 1.

1 This bill will revise Title 34-A, section 1210,
2 subsection 5, by deleting the word "vehicles" from
3 paragraph D and adding paragraph E to provide for
4 capital expenditures for replacement of equipment and
5 vehicles.
