- 6. Salary and duties. Except as provided in subsections 15 and 16, the power to employ and prescribe the duties of other personnel as the board
 shall deem necessary. Except as prescribed in subsection 15, the appointment and compensation of that
 staff shall be subject to the Civil Service Law;

- 12 16. Executive director. The board may appoint
 an executive director who shall serve at the pleasure
 of the board and who shall assist the board in carrying out its administrative duties and responsibilities under this chapter. The salary range for the

 the range established by Title 2, section 6-C.

19 STATEMENT OF FACT

- Notwithstanding a provision in the law dealing with the Board of Registration in Medicine which allows the board to set employee salaries, the Attorney General has held that those positions are in the Civil Service System and that the salary ranges are to be set by the personnel department.
- This new draft authorizes the appointment of an executive director to the board who would be outside the Civil Service System and authorizes salary range 89, \$36,732 \$53,643, for the director.
- Funds and position count are included in the board's 1987-88 budget and will be covered by dedicated revenues.
