2 This new draft repeals the statutory smelt season, method of fishing and limit on possession of smelts. The smelt fishery has been a viable fishery 3 4 5 in the State for many years. Regional variation in smelt management is essential due to differences in geography, smelt populations and traditional fishing preferences. This new draft gives the Commissioner 7 8 9 of Marine Resources the ability to regulate the fish-10 ery in a flexible manner.

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
