Any minor who violates this section commits a civil violation for which a forfeiture shall be adjudged of not less than \$100 or nor more than \$300 for the first offense; not less than \$200 or nor more than \$500 for the 2nd offense, none of which may be suspended, except as provided in paragraph B; and \$500 for the 3rd and subsequent of
.5 .6	fenses, none of which may be suspended, except as provided in paragraph B.

1	A. When a person is adjudged to have committed
2	his first offense under this section, the judge
3	shall inform that person that the forfeitures for
4	the 2nd and subsequent offenses are mandatory and
5	cannot be suspended, except as provided in para-
6	graph B. Failure to inform the first offender
7	that subsequent forfeitures are mandatory is not
8	a ground for suspension of any subsequent forfei-
9	ture.

10	B. The judge, as an alternative to or in addi-
11	tion to the civil forfeitures required by this
12	subsection, may assign the minor to perform spec-
13	ified work for the benefit of the State, the mu-
14	nicipality or other public entity or charitable

institution.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This new draft clarifies that community service may be assigned at the judge's discretion, and may serve as an alternative to the civil fines or may be in addition to the fines.
