STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Develop a Managed Care Insurance Plan Demonstration for Uninsured Individuals and Repeal of the Catastrophic Illness Program Law.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the funds currently supporting the Catastrophic Illness Program are to be used for the Managed Care Insurance Plan Demonstration; and

Whereas, the Department of Human Services should not take any more applications for the Catastrophic Illness Program after June 30, 1987; and

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1 Whereas, the rest of the funds remaining in the 2 program should not lapse on June 30, 1987, and should 3 be used for those persons remaining in the Cata-4 strophic Illness Program after June 30, 1987; and

5 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 6 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 7 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 8 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-9 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now, 10 therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 12 follows:

13 Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3185, as amended by PL 1985, c. 14 501, Pt. B, §19, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

16 §3185. Medical expenses for catastrophic illness

The Department of Human Services shall cease ac-17 18 cepting applications for assistance through the Catastrophic Medical Expense Fund on June 30, 1987. 19 The 20 Department of Human Services shall continue to pro-21 vide financial assistance to, or on behalf of, families or individuals residing in the State meeting el-igibility requirements for the catastrophic illness 22 23 24 program up to a period of one year after June 30, 25 1987.

Any balance of funds in the Catastrophic Medical Expense Fund account on June 30, 1987, shall not lapse and shall be utilized to provide financial assistance to, or on behalf of, families or individuals residing in this State meeting eligibility requirements for Catastrophic Illness Program on June 30, 1987.

without health insurance in one urban and one rural site.

The department shall target enrollment in this plan to low-income non-Medicaid eligible individuals, both employed and unemployed, who cannot afford to purchase individual or group coverage themselves. Enrollment in this plan shall not be offered to groups, individuals within groups and individuals that have been covered by health benefits coverage any time in the past 12 months, with the exception of individuals who were covered by Medicaid and individuals who had health benefit coverage and who have lost that coverage involuntarily and who otherwise would be eligible for the Managed Care Insurance Plan Demonstration.

The intent of this demonstration is to provide access to health benefits to those for whom financial barriers preclude the purchase of the coverage. Eligibility criteria for the Managed Care Insurance Plan Demonstration shall be developed by the department based upon the advice of The Robert Wood Johnson Foundation's grant advisory committee. For this 3-year demonstration, this health insurance plan shall be exempt from the provisions of Title 24, chapter 19 and Title 24-A, the Maine Insurance Code.

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41 42 The Department of Human Services shall prepare and submit to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over banking and insurance and the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over human resources of the 114th Legislature a report on the Managed Care Insurance Plan Demonstration during the 3rd year of the demonstration project. This report shall include, but not be limited to, the following information:

1. Assessment of the demonstrations' success in providing coverage. An assessment of the demonstrations' success in providing cost-effective affordable insurance coverage for acute and primary care services for the target population;

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1 2. Assessment whether the demonstration should 2 be continued. An assessment of whether the demon-3 stration should be continued, expanded incrementally 4 to additional areas of the State, made a statewide 5 project or discontinued; and

6 <u>3. Assessment of plan contracting and competi-</u> 7 <u>tive bidding options. An assessment of plan con-</u> 8 <u>tracting and competitive bidding options and a review</u> 9 <u>of options for program structure as a fully public or</u> 10 <u>semipublic entity.</u>

Sec. 4. Appropriation. The following funds are appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this Act.

STATEMENT OF FACT

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9 10 This new draft is designed to:

Enable the Department of Human Services to 1. use the balance in the Catastrophic Medical Expense Fund account on June 30, 1987, to pay for appropriate medical bills for individuals eligible for the Catastrophic Illness Program on June 30, 1987;

11 Ensure that there will be sufficient funds to 12 pay for these individual's bills by clarifying that 13 the last date for catastrophic illness eligibility is 14 June 30, 1987;

15 Clarify that the report on the Maine Managed з. 16 Care Insurance Plan Demonstration will be forwarded to the Joint Standing Committee on Banking and Insur-18 ance and the Joint Standing Committee on Human Resources of the 114th Legislature; and
