STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Amend the State Retirement Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

5 MRSa §18506, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1985, c. 801, §§5 and 7, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently, those who retire may draw social security and retirement with no offset. However, if a person is disabled there is an offset. The intent of this bill is to eliminate the offset for the disabled, thus treating all retirees alike.
