L9 20	This amendment corrects a grammatical error in the first section.
21 22 23 24 25 26 27	This amendment also reduces the time that a new member of an organization must wait before participating in any game of chance sponsored by the organization. The original bill set this waiting period at 30 days, and this amendment reduces the time to 14 days. This waiting period does not affect any other rights, privileges or responsibilities of members of the organization.
