AN ACT Concerning Smoking in Restaurants.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §1579-A is enacted to read:

§1579-A. Smoking in restaurants

1. Definitions. As used in this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, the following terms have the following meanings.

A. "Restaurant" means any enclosed indoor restaurant or other enclosed indoor establishment which invites the public to be served food for consumption on the premises.
