HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1177, L.D. 1606,
Bill, "AN ACT to Equalize Retirement Credits for Air
and Army National Guardsmen."

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting
clause the following:

'Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §1094, sub-§13, as repealed and
replaced by PL 1985, c. 790, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill by renumbering the sec-
tions to read consecutively.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment repeals a section of the old re-
tirement system laws which was not repealed when the
law was recodified last year. One part of subsection
13 conflicts with the proposed bill. As written,
subsection 13 discourages state employees from join-
ing the national guard because they would lose the
ability to buy service time under the Maine State Re-
tirement System if they accrued the right to a mili-
tary pension through service in the Maine National
Guard. The bill proposes to deny the right to pur-
chase service credits only if an individual had ac-
crued the right to a military pension prior to join-
ing state service.

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
