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HOUSE AMENDMENT "^A" to H.P. 1180, L.D. 1609,
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Postgraduate Residency Re-
quirements for Certain Physicians."

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Amend the bill in subsection 5 by adding at the
end a new paragraph to read:

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'This subsection shall apply only to persons entering
into a contract under Title 20-A, chapter 421, on or
before December 31, 1984.'

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This amendment reduces the 2-year postgraduate
training requirement to one year only for persons who
signed a contract for the State's program for post-
graduate education at a time when this training re-
quirement was for one year. The original bill re-
duced it for all applicants and the new draft reduced
it for all persons taking part in the State's educa-
tion program regardless of when they entered the pro-
gram.

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
