'Sec. 11. Study. The joint standing committee of
the Legislature having jurisdiction over appropri-
ations and financial affairs shall conduct a study to
evaluate and determine the cost of implementing the
administrative structure of the vocational-technical
institute system as a body corporate and politic and
a public instrumentality of the State. This study
shall include financial and personnel administration.
In addition, this study shall evaluate the cost of
implementing the administrative structure proposed by
the board of trustees following their review of the
system.'
