13	'1. Eligibility; retired teacher members. Any
14	retired teacher who receives a retirement benefit
15 16	from the Maine State Retirement System shall be eli- gible for group accident and sickness or health in-
10	surance. Retired teachers may not be required to
18	maintain a dues-paying membership in any organization
19	as a requirement for participation in a group health
20	insurance plan under this subsection.'
21	Further amend the bill in section 3, by striking
22	out all of lines 7 to 11 in the appropriation (page
23	3, lines 33 to 37 in L.D) and inserting in their
24	place the following:
25	'All Other \$467,823 \$580,430'
26	Further amend the bill by inserting before the
27	statement of fact the following:
28	'FISCAL NOTE
29	This bill will increase the number of retired
30	teachers eligible for the 10% state paid health in-
31	surance. This will require an additional General
32	Fund appropriation of \$220,000 in fiscal year 1987-88
33 34	and \$250,000 in fiscal year 1988-89. The additional number of retired teachers will also increase group
34	rates for teachers. The resulting additional cost to
36	local school units will increase school subsidies as
