SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1201, L.D. 1638,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Terms of Office for Trust ees of the Kennebec Water District."

10 Amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all 11 of section 5 and inserting in its place the follow-12 ing:

'Sec. 5. Trustees. All the affairs of the water district shall be managed by a board of trustees com-posed of 7 members. Two of the trustees shall be 13 14 15 the trustees shall 16 chosen by the municipal officers of Waterville, 2 by 17 the municipal officers of Fairfield, 2 by the municipal officers of Winslow and one shall be appointed by 18 19 the municipal officers of Benton or the municipal officers of Vassalboro to fill a seat which alternates 20 ricers of Vassalboro to fill a seat which alternates every 3 years between those towns. As soon as conve-nient after the members of the board have been cho-sen, the trustees shall hold a meeting at the city rooms in the City of Waterville and organize by the election of a president and clerk, adopt a corporate converse. 21 22 23 24 25 26 seal and, when necessary, may choose a treasurer and 27 all other necessary officers and agents for the prop-28 er conduct and management of the affairs of the dis-29 trict. Whenever the term of office of a trustee ex-30 pires, the body which appointed the trustee shall ap-31 point a successor to serve a full term of 3 years; 32 and, in case any other vacancy arises, it shall be filled in like manner for the unexpired term. The 33 34 trustees may also ordain and establish such bylaws as necessary for their convenience and the proper man-agement of the district's affairs. The trustees may 35 36 37 procure an office and incur such expenses as may be 38 necessary.

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1 2 3	imbursement for travel and expenses up to a maximum of \$500 per year, unless changed in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35, chapter 262.
4	The term of office for trustees shall be 3 years,
5	beginning on the first Monday in April as follows:
6	The term of the trustee from Benton or Vassalboro
7	shall begin in April 1988 with a trustee from
8	Vassalboro and continue with a trustee from Benton
9	beginning in April 1991, continuing to alternate be-
10	tween the towns every 3 years thereafter; the terms
11	of one trustee from Waterville, one from Fairfield
12	and one from Winslow shall begin in April 1989 and
13	every 3 years thereafter; and the terms of one trust-
14	ee from Waterville, one from Fairfield and one from
15	Winslow shall begin in April 1990 and every 3 years
16	thereafter. No person may serve more than 2 full
17	terms consecutively without a break in service before
18	reappointment.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment requires that the trustee in the The seat on the Board of Trustees alternate between Benton and Vassalboro and be appointed by the municipal officers instead of by the county commission as at present.
