2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9	Provides funds for per diem and related expenses for 2 meetings of a 5-member subcommittee of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs for a Liquor Pricing Study.'
10	STATEMENT OF FACT
11 12 13 14 15 16	This amendment makes 3 technical corrections to the bill as amended by the Senate amendment. First, the name of the Joint Standing Committee on Legal Affairs was inadvertently left out of section 5 of the bill, so that it is unclear that the 5-member subcommittee was to be a subcommittee of the legal affairs committee. This amendment clarifies that provision.
18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25	Second, the amendment corrects the appropriation section to delete the reference to 5 positions for the study. This was incorrectly included in the section to refer to the 5 Legislators serving on the subcommittee and was never intended to create 5 new positions. The appropriation section is replaced with that line eliminated and the legislative account correctly named.

Third, the amendment clarifies that the Department of Finance will finance its share of the costs of the study using its current resources. The term allocation is not necessarily appropriate in all situations that the department may face in undertaking this study.
