1 2 3	AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Lincoln Water District.
4 5 6	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
7 8 9	Whereas, this legislation affects the procedures which the Lincoln Water District trustees are to follow before calling a meeting;
0 1 2	Whereas, these changes should be in effect before the next meeting of the Lincoln Water District, presently scheduled for mid-May; and

- Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
- 7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1. P&SL 1949, c. 116, §10, as amended by 10 P&SL 1981, c. 104, §6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
- 12 Sec. 10. Annual meeting of district. After the acceptance of this charter and the organization of the board, the annual meeting of the district shall 13 14 15 be held within the district on the 2nd Tuesday 16 May, at such hour and place as may be designated by resolution of the board of trustees as provided in the bylaws. Notice of the meeting shall be published 17 18 19 newspaper of local circulation not less than 7 20 days before the meeting. The board may schedule regular meetings as it determines necessary with notice 21 22 provided in a like manner. Emergency meetings of the board may be called by the chairman or any 2 trustees as necessary without that published notice, but the 23 24 25 media shall be provided with the same notice as 26 board. All meetings of the board shall be subject to

30 Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited 31 in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when ap-32 proved. 1

2 The purpose of this bill is to permit the Lincoln 3 Water District trustees to hold meetings as necessary without the necessity of advertising twice and posting notice of the hearing in public places. The bill 5 6 also requires that the board of trustees no need turn every meeting into a public hearing. Under the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35, whenever there 7 8 9 is a proposed change in rates or an issuance of 10 by the district, the district must always give the 11 public notice and hold a public hearing.

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
