HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1219, L.D. 1662,
Bill, "AN ACT Establishing the Commission to Study
the Impact of Game and Nongame Species on Maine's
Economy."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and
before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that the commis-
sion begin its work immediately in order to fulfill
its duties and make its report to the Second Regular
Session of the 113th Legislature; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect
when approved.'
