	6	38 MRSA §590-A is enacted to read:
	7	§590-A. License terms
	8 9 10 11 12	The term of air emission licenses is 5 years, ex- cept that the board may establish, by rule, shorter license terms for the following source categories as it deems necessary to protect the public health, safety and welfare:
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1. Waste incinerators. Sources designed to burn 1 solid waste for which a municipality is responsible 2 pursuant to section 1305; 3

4 2. Innovative control. Sources utilizing new or innovative air pollution control technology; and 5

3. New sources. New sources that have not pre-6 7. viously received an air emissions license from the department and those individual emission sources that 8 9. have not previously been included in an air emissions 10 license.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this new draft is to shift 12 most 13 air emission licenses to a 5-year term while allowing the Department of Environmental Protection to estab-14 lish shorter license terms for specific categories of 15 16 sources requiring more frequent scrutiny.

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
