STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Establish Field Offices of the Maine Land Use Regulation Commission. Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. l. 12 MRSA §685, as amended by PL 1979, c. 541, Pt. A, §128, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The commission shall establish and maintain at least 2 field offices, one in Greenville and one in Ashland, designed principally to provide assistance to the public on permit applications and to carry out such other functions of the commission as appropriate. These field offices shall be established in locations chosen to provide the maximum benefit to the

Historic levels of permitting activity, the convenience of access and the availability and cost of office facilities shall be considered in choosing the field office locations. Each office shall be open on a part-time basis at least 2 days a month or as public demand for the ser- vices of such field offices warrant and as resources allow. Whenever practicable, the commission shall make use of existing personnel to staff these field offices.
