AN ACT to Clarify the Site Location Law.

3 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
4 follows:

5 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §488, last ¶, as enacted by PL
6 1983, c. 819, Pt. A, §64, is amended to read:

7 Development which consists only of a subdivision
8 or subdivisions located entirely within the area of
9 the State subject to the jurisdiction of the Maine
10 Land Use Regulation Commission under Title 12, chap-
11 ter 206-A, is exempt from the requirements of this
12 ~~Article~~ article. New construction which is not a "de-
13 velopment which may substantially affect the environ-
14 ment" at an existing manufacturing facility is exempt
15 from review under this article provided that the ad-

ditional disturbed area not to be revegetated does not exceed 30,000 square feet in any calendar year. When review under this article is required for development at an existing manufacturing facility, the applicant shall provide plans for the new development as well as for those activities which have been undertaken pursuant to this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this new draft is to exempt minor additions to existing manufacturing facilities from review under the site location law by the Department of Environmental Protection.
