AN ACT to Revise Reporting Procedures Related
to Criminal History Record
Information.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6209 is enacted to read:

§6209. Commissioner to keep records

The commissioner shall collect and maintain criminal history record information pertinent to violations of chapters 601 to 627. He may collect and maintain other records and information pertinent to other functions of the department, including the enforcement of civil violations.

1 Section 3 requires the court to send information
2 specified by the State Bureau of Identification to
3 the bureau.

4 The Maine Revised Statutes, Title 29, section
5 2304, requires the courts to provide information to
6 the Secretary of State pertaining to Title 29 and
7 other motor vehicle violations and to the Commission-
8 er of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife for certain vio-
9 lations found in Title 12, section 7905.
