12	lines 1 to 8 in L.D.) and inserting in their place

14 15 16 17 18	'1. Fire department. "Fire department" means a municipal fire department, as defined in Title 30, section 3771, subsection 1, or a voluntary association, as defined in Title 30, section 3771, subsection 3.
19	2. Firefighter. "Firefighter" means a municipal
20	firefighter, as defined in Title 30, section 3771,
21	subsection 2, or a volunteer firefighter, as defined
22	in Title 30, section 3771, subsection 4.
23	Further amend the Bill in that part designated
24	" <u>§2103.</u> " in subsection 6, in the 3rd paragraph, in
25	the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 4, lines 40 and 41 in
26	L.D.) by striking out the following: " <u>aramid or</u>
27	<u>other</u> "
28	STATEMENT OF FACT
29	This amendment makes a technical correction to
30	make the definitions of "fire department" and
31	"firefighter" consistent with the definitions for
32	those terms in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30.
33	This is not a change in the intent or effect of the
34	new draft.

1 2 HOUSE AMENDMENT """ to H.P. 1234, L.D. 1686

1 This amendment also removes language referring to 2 a specific synthetic material, "aramid" which has 3 thermal protection properties because it is unclear 4 whether that name is a trade name. The remaining 5 language is sufficient to ensure that fabric with the 6 same thermal protection is used in harnesses for 7 self-contained breathing apparatus. Again, this does 8 not change the intent or effect of the new draft.
