11	Amend the Bill in the first line after the enact-
12	ing clause (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out
13	the following: "Sec. 1."
14 15 16	Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated " <u>\$7061.</u> " by inserting after subsection 6 the following:
17	'7. Reclassification requests. The bureau shall
18	act as expeditiously as possible on job reclassifica-
19	tion requests which occur while this section is in
20	effect. Nothing in this section may be construed to
21	authorize the bureau to defer from acting expedi-
22	tiously on job reclassification requests while the
23	issue of job classifications is being addressed pur-
24	suant to this section.
25	8. Report. The director shall submit a progress
26	report on or before February 15, 1988, to the joint
27	standing committee of the Legislature having juris-
28	diction over state and local government.
29 30	9. Sunset. Subsection 3 is repealed March 15, 1988.'
31 32 33	Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated " <u>§7061.</u> " by renumbering the subsections to read consecutively.
34 35	Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2.
