HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 1237, L.D. 1689,  
Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Civil Service Law to Set

Amend the Bill in the first line after the enact-  
ing clause (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out  
the following: "Sec. 1."

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part  
designated "§7061." by inserting after subsection 6  
the following:

'7. Reclassification requests. The bureau shall  
act as expeditiously as possible on job reclassifica-  
tion requests which occur while this section is in  
effect. Nothing in this section may be construed to  
authorize the bureau to defer from acting expedi-  
tiously on job reclassification requests while the  
issue of job classifications is being addressed pur-  
suant to this section.

8. Report. The director shall submit a progress  
report on or before February 15, 1988, to the joint  
standing committee of the Legislature having juris-  
diction over state and local government.

9. Sunset. Subsection 3 is repealed March 15,  
1988.'

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purposes of this amendment are to require the  
bureau to act expeditiously on job reclassification  
requests, to include a progress report requirement on  
the part of the parties and to include a sunset pro-  
vision. The amendment also deletes section 2 of the  
bill.
