STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD  
NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Require an Insurance Agent or  
Broker to be Located at each Place of  
Business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
follows:

24-A MRS.A §1543 is enacted to read:

§1543. Duty to have agent or broker at each place of  
business

Each place of business maintained by an insurance  
agent or broker for the purpose of transacting insur-  
ance shall be under the supervision of an insurance  
broker or agent. Any insurance broker or agent who

1 has established one or more places of business for  
2 the purpose of transacting insurance shall assign at  
3 least one separate broker or agent to each location,  
4 including the location of its headquarters, and shall  
5 give written notice to the Superintendent of Insur-  
6 ance containing the location of each office and the  
7 agent or broker responsible for each office.
