5 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as

7 34-A MRSA §3032, sub-§6, ¶B, as enacted by PL
8 1983, c. 459, §6, is amended to read:

9 B. He is entitled to the right to be present at
10 the hearing, except that he may be prevented from
11 attending or be removed if his behavior indicates
12 that he is a danger to himself, other persons or
13 property.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 This new draft clarifies that a committee offend-
3 er may not be prevented from attending his disciplin-
4 ary hearing or be removed from the hearing unless he
5 poses a danger to himself, other persons or to prop-
6 erty.

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
