In municipalities having a population of 18 5,000 persons or less: Year-round qualified catering services 19 (1) 20 must have a minimum gross income of \$5,000 a 21 year from the sale of food to the public; 22 and (2) Part-time qualified catering services must have a minimum gross income of \$2,500 23 24 25 from the sale of food to the public as a re-26 quirement for a part-time license not in ex-27 cess of 6 consecutive months.
