4 5 6	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
7 8	Whereas, the 90-day period will not expire until after the first week of June; and

Whereas, the first full week of June has been proclaimed by the Governor as Garden Week every year for many years; and

- Whereas, the Maine Federation of Garden Clubs is an organization which has given countless volunteer hours beautifying the municipal, recreational and open spaces of Maine towns and cities; and
- Whereas, the National Council of State Garden Clubs has asked the Maine Federation of Garden Clubs to join with other states in seeking legislation to establish the first full week of June as Garden Week
- 10 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, 11 these facts create an emergency within the meaning of 12 the Constitution of Maine and require the following 13 legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-14 vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
- 16 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as 17 follows:
