The amount of reimbursement to each municipality shall be an amount equal to:
21 22 23	A. Fifty percent of all general assistance granted to that municipality below the .0003% of all state valuation amount; or
24 25 26	B. Reasonable administrative costs of the municipality's general assistance program, defined as 10% of net general assistance cost.
27 28 29	Each municipality shall elect to be reimbursed under paragraph A or B at the beginning of the fiscal year for which reimbursement is sought.
