HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to S.P. 572, L.D. 1707,
Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Organization of the
Maine Sardine Council."

Amend the bill by inserting after the title and
before the enacting clause the following:

'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis-
lature do not become effective until 90 days after
adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the Maine Sardine Council has business
meetings scheduled for the summer months this year;
and

Whereas, because of seasonal demands in the
sardine industry, a quorum is often difficult to at-
tain during the summer months; and

Whereas, this bill will alleviate the difficulty
of the council in attaining a quorum so that business
may be conducted; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature,
these facts create an emergency within the meaning of
the Constitution of Maine and require the following
legislation as immediately necessary for the preser-
vation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,'

Further amend the bill in that part designated
"§4693." in subsection 1 (page 2, line 4 in L.D.) by
striking out the following: "4 members" and insert-
ing in its place the following: "51% of the members'

Further amend the bill by inserting before the
statement of fact the following:
