14	6. Timber harvesting. "Timber harvesting" means
15	the cutting and removal of trees from their growing
16	site and the attendant operation of cutting and
17	skidding machinery but not the construction or cre-
18	ation of roads. Timber harvesting does not include
19 .	the clearing of land for approved construction.
20	Within the strip extending 50 feet inland from the
21	normal high watermark, a cleared opening or openings
22	not greater than 30 feet in width for every 100 feet
23	of shoreline may be created, provided that when open-
24 25	ings are combined, there shall be no single opening along the shore wider than 60 feet, and there shall
26	along the shore wider than 60 feet, and there shall be no more than one 60-foot opening along 200 feet of
27	shoreline. Notwithstanding other provisions of this
28	subsection, timber harvesting is prohibited in the
29	area extending 250 feet inland from the normal high
30	watermark in those areas zoned for natural resources
