10 11	Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in its place the following:
12 13	'AN ACT Concerning the Receiving, Witnessing or Accepting of Absentee Ballots.'
14 15 16	Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:
17 18 19	'2. Class D crime. The commission of any act described as follows in this subsection is a Class D crime:
20 21 22	A. A person who forges the name of another on an absentee ballot, return envelope or the application for an absentee ballot $\tau$ ;
23 24 25 26 27	B. Notwithstanding this subchapter, a candidate who delivers, receives, accepts, notarizes or witnesses an absentee ballot, other than his own absentee ballot, furnished by the clerk of a municipality in this State; or
28 29 30 31 32	C. A person, not employed directly by a municipality, who delivers, receives, accepts, notarizes or witnesses an absentee ballot, other than his own absentee ballot, for any kind of compensation whatsoever.'

## HOUSE AMENDMENT "#" to H.P. 1254, L.D. 1712

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5	This amendment prohibits a campaign worker, a PAC representative or any other person receiving any type of compensation whatsoever from handling absentee ballots.
6 7 8	This amendment does not alter the original bill's wording which makes it a Class D crime for a candidate to handle absentee ballots in any manner.
